## Policy

Office of the Vice President of Student Affairs

University Housing for reasons of health, normal maintenance, upholding community standards, fire and safety, or to address instances of room damage, necessary repairs to room furniture, in cases of health and safety, room furnishings, or room furniture. A search of a room/apartment/suite will be made only with: (1) his or her consent; or (2) a University Search Authorization issued by the Vice President of Student Affairs or designee; or (3) a warrant from a judge, court, or law enforcement search.

give rise to a belief that a search will

be conducted that is not in the best interests of the community. The search of a room/apartment/suite will be conducted only when there is a reasonable suspicion of a violation of the Boston College community standards. A University Search Authorization will set forth the premises, the person or persons to be searched, and the date, time, and location of the search. The search will remain valid within which the warrant will remain valid.

A search based upon a University Search Authorization will be conducted by the Boston College Police Department or the Director of Residential Life or their designees and other university officials deemed appropriate in the situation.
