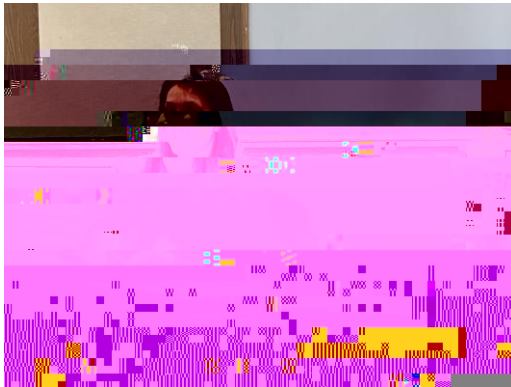
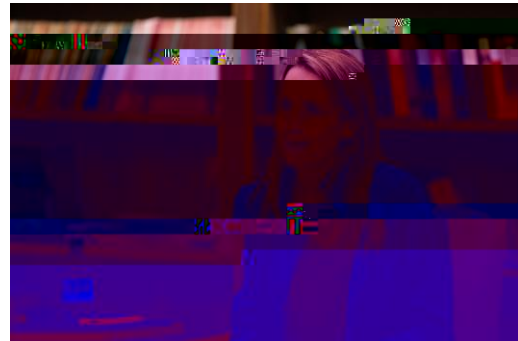

Andres Lisher '96, Head of Americas for J.P. Morgan Asset Management, spoke to students about freeing their minds from the stress of not knowing what the future may

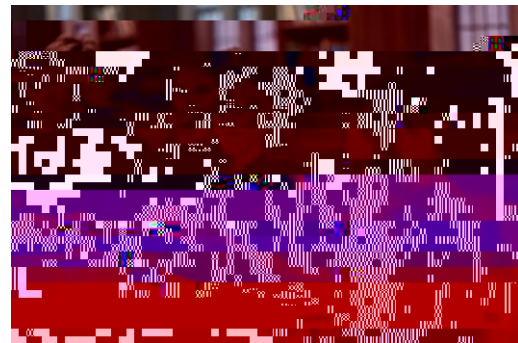


I Belong
