Cross-sectional observational pilot study

34 patients admitted to a public hospital in Rio de Janeiro

Structured questionnaire based on Nanda risk factors for falls and the Morse fall score.

Descriptive statistical data analysis

Age > 65	6	18
blood glucose alteration	4	12
impaired mobility	4	12
