This course aims at leading the sturbent towards an understanding of the unity that underlies the diversity of the social sciences. It is in the shift of the answer to the <u>enduring question</u> how do we understand human nature that ultimately grounds the unity among the various social sciences.

The distinctive features of each of the contemporary social-scientific disciplines can be understood only by understanding the common ground from which they sprangthe transition from late medieval to modern times. The student is first led to see the
