

Specializations

In the School of Social Work students must choose a specialized practice: clinical practice or macro practice. Clinical students focus on practice directly with individuals, families, and groups in dealing with personal, interpersonal, and social problems. Macro students develop specific knowledge and skills to achieve change in organizational and community settings.

Field of Practice

Prior to entering the third year, students will choose a field of practice from one of the following areas: Afrocentric Social Work; Children, Youth, & Families; Health; Latinx Communities; or Mental Health. Dual degree students are also eligible to take a Global Field of Practice. However, they are not eligible for an international Spring block field placement.
