owens: Your recent book is about the 1960 election. Could you explain the final stages of the campaign, with a Catholic candidate against a candidate who was born a Quaker and the political context surrounding that?

casey: September of 1960 was the most dramatic moment in terms of the religion issue. Kennedy had a group of pollsters who came to him and people were against him because he was Catholic and **Erik Owens** after his presentation comparing the 1960 and 2008 presidential elections at the Boisi Center.

He was very adept, did a great job, and was rewarded with an ambassadorship after the election.
