Earlier this week, Boston College students living off campus on Foster Street in the Brighton community reported to both the Boston and Boston College Police that an unknown person or persons entered their apartment through an unsecured door while they were home and stole two laptops.

As a reminder the Boston College Police Departments encourages you to do the following:

Lock your doors and windows. This includes patio doors and windows on upper floors, and keep those access points secured at all times.

Be aware of your surroundings and get to know your neighbors. Report suspicious persons or behavior to police.

A void leaving valuables in plain sight from windows.

Ensure that your devices are password protected and for Find My Device Apps are active.

Take advantage of BCPD's <u>FREE\_Operation Identification</u> Engraving Program, and have your valuables engraved and serial numbers recorded.
